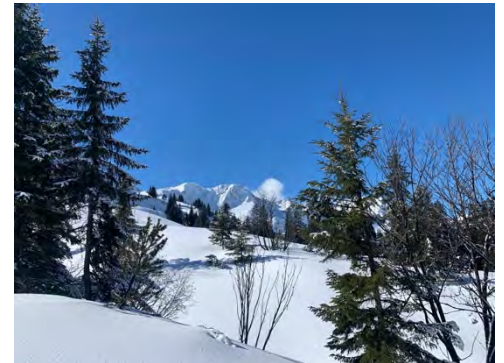
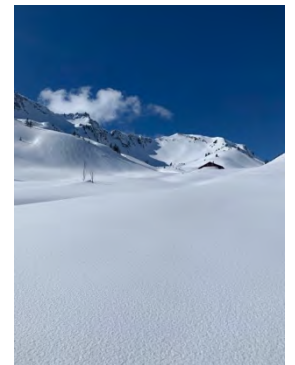


Snowshoe Hiking and Winter Safety Course in the Kleinwalsertal



Highlights

- Three snowshoe day tours through alpine winter wonderland of Kleinwalsertal led by certified International Mountain Leader
- Learning about tour-planning, equipment and basic avalanche awareness
- Learning and practice of avalanche rescue technique
- Idyllic and comfortable base



Sunday 22nd – Tuesday 24th January 2023

Meeting point: Tour Car Park, Auenhütte

DAY 1: Auenhütte – Schwarzwasserhütte

DAY 2: Peak around Schwarzwasserhütte

DAY 3: Peak or pass around Schwarzwasserhütte and descent

Tour time: Approx 4-6 hrs per day



Included:

- ✓ 3 days guided snowshoe hikes and course with German and English speaking International Mountain Leader
- ✓ 2 nights lodging in 4 bed- rooms
- ✓ 2 days half board (2x 3- course dinner, 2 x breakfast, 1l hot water for tea each day)
- ✓ Snowshoe, pole hire (if needed)
- ✓ Pre-tour information package (including local information, equipment & travel guide)

Activity level requirements

This is an easy- medium difficulty tour. We mostly travel along gentle slopes (20°) with some steeper (30°) slopes. The tour is suitable for beginner snowshoe hikers and winter walkers with previous experience. You should have hiking experience and a good level of fitness for 4-6 hours of hiking with the snowshoes and be able to comfortably hike 800m in ascent and descent. With a good head for heights and sure-footedness, you can hike steeper terrain with ease.

Snowshoe & Course Equipment List

- Waterproof hiking boots with ankle support and good profile (B/C)
- Rucksack (25-35l) with rain cover
- Waterproof & windproof outer layer – *preferably 2.5-3 layer system* (Jacket with hood)
- One pair of long hardshell/ touring trousers
- 2 pairs hiking socks
- 2 long sleeved base layers (synthetic or merino wool/ quick-drying)
- 1 base layer legging/ long-johns
- Fleece, extra warm layer or soft shell jacket
- Gaiters
- Underwear
- Gloves: one thin pair, one thick pair
- Hat, scarf/buff, headband
- Sun protection (Sunglasses, sunhat, sun cream, lip salve)
- Thermos (1 litre)
- Headlamp/ torch
- Snowshoes & poles with snow plates*
- Avalanche safety gear – Beacon, Probe and Shovel (LVS Set)*
- First aid set and personal medication
- Bivvay bag*
- Mobile phone/ camera & charger
- Hut sleeping bag/ sleeping bag liner
- Wash kit, soap, flannel and small lightweight towel
- Hut shoes/ slippers
- Ear plugs
- Snacks
- Notebook & pen
- Wallet including cash
- Personal insurance details (please ensure that your insurance covers you for alpine activities- if you need advice in this area- get in touch!)
